

General Information

You have chosen aluminum furniture that started as a melted liquid which was poured into a mold and cooled. This “casting” was then sanded carefully by hand. The series of castings that make up your pattern were then welded together, cleaned and painted. Because the furniture is solid aluminum, there will be no rusting over its lifetime.

- These quality **Aluminum frames** have been finished with an electrostatically applied powder-coated nylon paint for a durable long-lasting finish. This state-of-the-art finish is warranted by the manufacturers against peeling and flaking due to defective painting.

Annual Maintenance

- Periodic hosing of the furniture with a hard spray from a garden hose will dislodge dirt, food and airborne pollutants from the frames.
- AT SEASON’S END: Using a diluted solution of water and any **liquid cleaner (preferably one containing “pine”)** wipe down the frames of the furniture. Rinse well.
- WINTER STORAGE: Your aluminum frames are designed to withstand the rigors of winter. To keep the furniture looking good and to extend its lifetime, ***we strongly recommend that you use plastic covers for the winter.*** Our Patio Shops stock a full line of protective covers for individual pieces of furniture, or large covers that will protect both the table and all of the dining chairs.
- All frames should be stored in the upright position, to avoid damage from condensate inside the frames freezing and “bursting”, which is not covered under warranty.

Maintaining Your Sales Receipt & Records

You will need to file your new receipts for the future. You will need the style numbers and color codes to correctly order parts or to replace the vinyl feet glides if they wear out.
